GOOD TO KNOW - Tips before arriving at MPIK-Heidelberg



Access and transportation

The access to MPIK by car is unproblematic.

By public transportation, however it is not very simple. From the Train Station (Hbf) – you first need to take a tram or bus until *Bismarckplatz* (main connection point in Heidelberg) and from there take either:

- Bus 39 (direction Königstuhl) directly to the stop called *MPI-Kernphysik* or
- Bus 39A (direction Mombertplatz) to stop *Bierhelderhof* and then walk 3 min up to the main entrance of MPIK



WI-FI in the MPIK-Campus

- Once you've received your room key at the main entrance you can also request free Wi-Fi-access in Campus
- The access will be automatically deactivated after 2 weeks. if you are staying longer please request new access data



Arriving on the weekend

- Bus connections are rare
- The EMBL canteen, usually used by MPIK-members for breakfast and lunch, is **closed**
- On Sundays shopping for food is only available at the Train Station
- Restaurants downtown and in the surroundings of the Institute are usually open during the weekend

Check-in Procedure

Individuals having booked a room in the guesthouse should report to the reception desk at the institute's main entrance to collect a check-in envelope with instructions, a key card which will open their apartment, and a key for the individual buildings. The reception is operated 24/7, but if guests arrive after business hours, there is a chance the security guard may be making his rounds. In this case, please dial **<u>768 615</u>** using the telephone on the outer wall of the main entrance reception area. You will hear a couple of beeps. Hang up and the security guard will call you back on this telephone and will then return to hand out your check-in envelope.
